- Provided training to Youth with support from Department of Environmental by Training Youth on Fibre Driving license's for youth

- Company grew from EME to QSE with an annual turn over of 22 Million in FY22
- Created employment for 60 youth in KZN, Gauteng Eastern Cape region.
- Promoted one female from Admin staff to supervisor position
