

Blocking categories offered by BlockCall Plus

- 1. All calls (except emergency and toll-free numbers)
- 2. National and international calls (except emergency, toll-free and local calls)
- 3. International calls (except emergency, toll-free, local, national, cellular and Telkom Premium Rate services)
- 4. Cellular and Telkom Premium Rate services (except emergency, toll-free, local, national and international calls)
- 5. Telkom Premium Rate services (except emergency, toll-free, local, national, international and cellular calls)
- 6. Cellular, Telkom Premium Rate services and international calls (except emergency, toll-free, local and national calls)

Note:

- Emergency and toll-free numbers (exempted from barring)
 10111, 107, 10177, 10131, 10132, 10133, 10134, 10135, 10136, 10137, 10210, 10212, 10217, 10219 and 0800.
- Cellular numbers barred: 06X,07X, 081-084.
- Telkom Premium Rate services barred: 08621, 08622 and 08671.
- The barring of national calls includes 081, 082, 083, 084, 072, 073, Maxicall 0861 and Maxinet 09X numbers.

What is an "allowed" list?

It is the selection of up to 30 telephone numbers that the main PIN holder can programme to be dialled out at any time.

Which telephone numbers can be programmed in an "allowed" list?

Any local, national, cellular, Telkom Premium Rate or international numbers; consisting of up to fourteen digits.
