We deliver the Future of converged ICT solutions to create sustainable economic, environmental and social value for all

We are committed to becoming **Carbon Neutral by 2035** and to achieve **Net Zero Emissions by 2040**.

Telkom has taken climate action by setting a net zero target in line with the 2015 Paris Agreement, and the Global System for Mobile Communications Association (GSMA). We are committed to playing our part in curbing global temperature rise to well-below 2°C above pre-industrial levels and pursuing efforts to limit warming to 1.5°C and have committed to setting a science-based target to be validated by the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi). In addition, we are aligned to the Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP) in our pathway towards becoming a leader on environmental transparency and action.



Telkom commits to responsibly mitigate our climate change impact through our energy, water and waste management practices in accordance with the following goals informed by the SBTi:

- 1. Carbon Neutral by 2035**
 - 100% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 emissions
 - Migration from fossil fuels to 50% by 2030 and 100% by 2035
 - 100% renewable energy by 2035
 - Migration from R22 Refrigerant gases by 25% in 2025 and 100% by 2035
- 2. Net Zero by 2040**
 - Determination of Scope 3 emissions from use of sold products
 - Encourage recyclable and bio-degradable materials
 - 75% reduction in waste to landfill by 2030
 - 50% reduction in potable water consumption by 2030
 - Carbon offsets for unavoidable emissions

 Manage and reduce water consumption

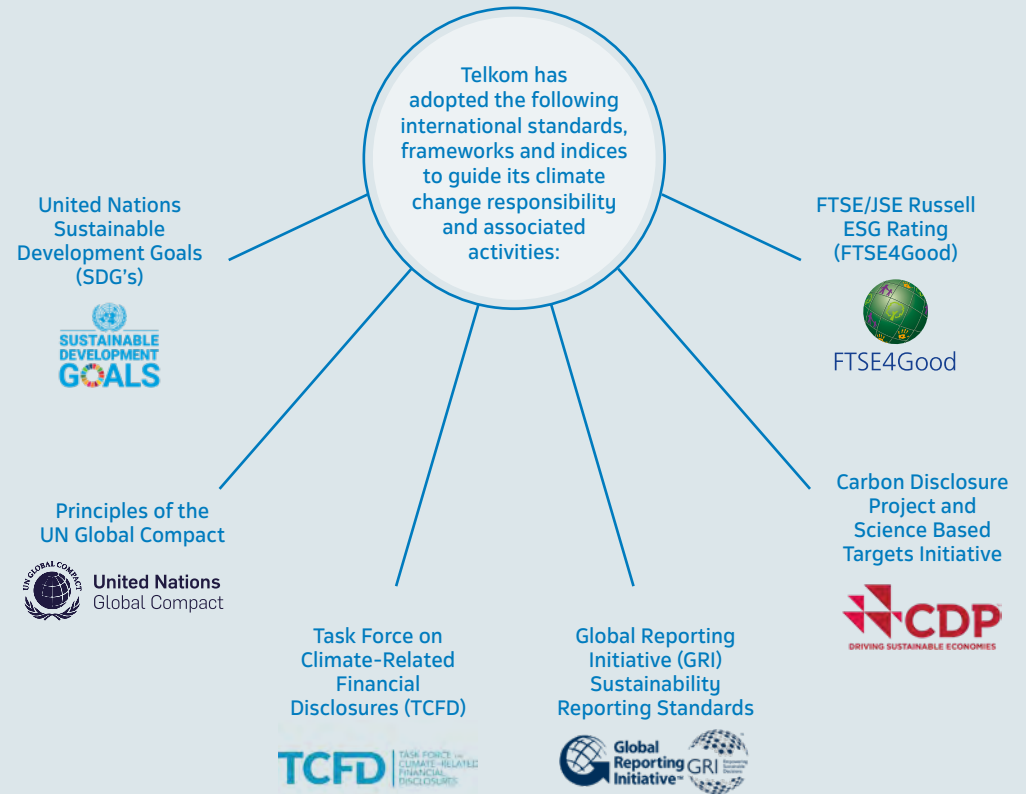
 Manage hazardous waste and improve recycling, especially e-waste
